

TO GREENPEACE

On September 28 2006, we received a letter forwarded to us by the Captain of the Commercial Port Vasiliy Belyaev from the leader of Greenpeace Nordic Mr. Truls Gulowsen with information that vessels under Georgian flag Carmen, Eva, Isabella, Juanita, Rosita which are tied up at the port point of Svetly at the quai side belonging to the Commercial Port are in the "black list" of NEAFC and it is necessary to take towards them necessary measures, including not providing fuel etc. The status of Russia as a signatory to NEAFC obligates this.

Based on the possibilities, goals and tasks of the State Administration Of the Fisheries Port, in order to support the activity of Greenpeace and the NEAFC commission we have made a decision to conduct an inspection of these vessels, as well as to not process ship documents, and documents of the crew of these vessels in order to prevent their leaving of the port of Kaliningrad until the appropriate organs take a substantiated decision on the given situation.

The RosSelKhozNadzor authority for Kaliningrad region received information that fishing vessels under Georgian flag Eva, Carmen, Isabella, Rosita, Dolphin are in the port of Kaliningrad. These vessels are in the list of international fisheries organizations NAFO and NEAFC as vessels that conduct illegal, unregulated and unreported (IUU) fishing.

In accordance with the requirements of NEAFC and NAFO, of which Russian Federation is a member, we ask you to take the necessary measure to forbid offloading, reloading, bunkering, supplying with water, provisions, agent services and other services of the vessels listed above, with the exception of force-majeur situations.
